Going to the beach has proper etiquettes. People are supposed to follow them on the beach. You can do anything to have fun, but still, there are rules to follow.

Once you arrive at the beach, you want to find an empty space. Observe the location and try to find a spot with a minimum of 15 feet (4.6 m) from anyone who is already there. Make sure the wind blows against the umbrella and insert it at an angle. This is to keep the umbrella in the sand so that it will not get blown away and hit other people.

Smoking is not prohibited outdoors, but the wind conditions can make smoke linger around people or travel for quite a distance. Unless you go to the beach outside peak times, you had better not smoke when spending time at the beach.

If you wear flip flops, do not get too close to other people's towels while walking. This is to avoid the sand from being flipping onto their towel. When you want to play a game, go away from the crowds. Playing ball over peoples' heads while they are trying to relax is incredibly disturbing.

After all day at the beach, when you want to go home, never shake your towel too close to your neighbor and see which way the wind is blowing so that you will not blow sand into your neighbor's face. In short, remember that people come to the beach to relax and your actions could spoil their day. So, keep a distance from your neighbors, be considerate, and make less noise while playing.
